Communion Reflection... What makes you be who you are? Is it your educational background, or the kind of work you do? Would it be the quality of your relationships with other? Well, all of the above of course, but something absolutely fundamental and essential is missing from this list. When God created you, God had an incredibly beautiful plan that is taking place within you at this very moment. God's plan was to be eternally present within you, caring for you and guiding you with infinite love. You are very precious to God. This most deeply expresses who you really are. God truly longs for our love and waits for our response to his love for us. Would this be a good time to deepen your awareness of God's love for you through grateful and silent prayer?



It should be no surprise that Jesus encountered lepers on more than one occasion. Leprosy was prevalent in those days, a devastating disease that could not be removed by anyone or anything... except Jesus. The same is true with sin. While not a physical disease that separates us from others, sin spiritually separates us from God, and it cannot be removed by anyone or anything... except Jesus. Humanitarian Relief - India's Covid-19 Outbreak

Since the pandemic began, India's Catholic Church, acting principally through Caritas India, has been supporting some of the most disadvantaged groups, such as those with inadequate housing, migrant labourers, persons with special needs and widows. Relief services and material provided by the Church, or with its support include: food at kitchens and distribution centers in slums, masks, sanitizers and hygiene kits, psychosocial support and hotline services, public education campaigns on infection prevention and vaccination, and supporting the public healthcare system from Church run clinics and hospitals. Soulfully happy individuals cherish all the people God has placed in their lives and never take them for granted. They own their faults and mistakes, liberating themselves from shame and guilt. There isn't a day they don't count their blessings and say, "Thank you."

On the Lighter Side: An old nun who was living in a convent next to a construction site noticed the coarse language of the workers and decided to spend some time with them to correct their ways. She decided she would take her lunch and sit with them, so she put the sandwich in a Brown bag and walked over to the spot where the men were eating.
