Pope Francis @Pontifex... Jesus cautions us about a religiosity of appearances: looking good on the outside, while failing to purify the heart. He does not want outward appearances. He wants to put faith back at the center. He wants a faith that touches the heart.

Communion Reflection... A man placed a plate of various kinds of fruit in front of his young son. The boy slowly surveyed the variety. Pointing to each one individually, the boy said, "Dad, I like that and that and maybe that, but I'm not going to try that or that." Some days I feel as though I tell God the same thing. "I don't mind if I have to go through this radiation, Lord, but I certainly don't want some of the other struggles." We're fortunate Jesus didn't pick and choose. He didn't agree to the whipping and crown of thorns but then refuse to be crucified. He didn't choose to pay for some of our sins but not all of them. He didn't choose salvation for some people but not all. He endured it ALL to pay for ALL our sins and for ALL people who accept him. Think about the times you would prefer to pick and choose, then pray - Heavenly Father, help me be mindful that you suffered all so I can inherit all.



My favourite parable is the Prodigal Son because of the father's reaction to the return of his son. He

doesn't stand at the doorway tapping his foot with arms crossed and a scowl on his face. He doesn't berate his son. He doesn't even say, "I told you so." He runs to his son, gives him a great big bear hug and kisses him all over his face. This is how our Lord Jesus reacts to us each and every day as we turn from our sinful ways and towards him for mercy. He doesn't give us a list of things to do. He doesn't punish us as our sins deserve. He sprints to us and gives us a huge bear hug of love and forgiveness. Let's pray, Lord Jesus, I am so sorry for running away from you. Thank you for running to me and engulfing me in your loving arms.
