Communion Reflection... When one of my nephews was just learning to talk, I taught him to say "thank you." And for a while, that's all he said. You'd tell him "good morning." He'd answer, "Thank you!" He'd leave to go play in his room and say, "Thank you!" before he left. If he handed you his toy, he'd tell you, "Thank you!" No matter where he was or what he was doing: "Thank you." That's a good habit, isn't it? No matter what happens, offer a little prayer of thanks. Even when something isn't going my way and I'm a little unhappy with another person, I can take a deep breath and, instead of complaining, start by praying, "Thank you, Lord." What a difference it makes to meet everything in my life by remembering God's love for me—and thanking him for it! Loving God, thank you for your love, which is with me no matter what.



Life can be hard. We all have bad days. We make mistakes, we do the wrong thing, we suffer accidents. We have to work hard when we feel like playing. But have you noticed something about those hard times? Have you noticed that the ways you've grown and become stronger, wiser and more understanding are often because of the difficulties and challenges, even suffering? No one likes hard times. We don't wish for suffering. We don't seek it, and we surely don't want to cause it. But since God is all powerful and all good, he can help us come closer to him, even through hard times. He uses whatever happens to us to bring us to him—if we let him. As Paul says, we should give thanks not just in good circumstances, but all circumstances. Lord, thank you for all the different parts of my life. May I grow closer to you through them.

We remember the more than 2,300,000 Canadians who have served throughout our nation's history and the more than 118,000 who made the ultimate sacrifice. This year, though we may not be able to gather at the cenotaph, we can still honour the brave men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice for their country.
