Communion Reflection... The world is being filled with grace. Every baptism, every new acceptance of the Good News, expands through the world the divine life of God. With every conversion to live his divine Life more authentically, the Word is made flesh more extensively on earth "until we all become one in faith and in the knowledge of God's Son, and from that perfect man who is Christ come to full stature." (Ephesians 4:13) This is the realization of God's plan for the fullness of time, to gather up all things in Christ, and make him the head over all things for the Church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all. This is the mystery of the Incarnation extended, the mystery of a world "full of grace." The world will be full of grace when all the members of his body are totally surrendered to Christ our Head. Then the Word will be made flesh as the glory of God shining through all humanity. This is the fulfillment of the promise.



There are several places in the Scriptures where God tells someone, "Don't be afraid." In all of these occasions, God is about to do something amazing. But if that's the case, why does God have to tell us not to be afraid? If he's doing something amazing, what is it so scary? The truth is that we are often more comfortable keeping God at a safe distance from us. We want to be warmed by the fire of God's love, but we sometimes don't want to stand too close to the flames. So before God can work a miracle in our lives, he has to tell us not to fear; he has to invite us closer so that the grime of our sinfulness can be burned away and we become more fully human and see more clearly. This journey began with the angel's words to Mary, "Do not be afraid." Now it's our turn to move closer to God. Lord help me to conquer the fears that keep me from drawing closer to you. Warm my heart with your love and transform my life.
