

Communion Reflection... Aristotle stated, "Time is the most unknown of all unknown things." It is a mystery we can't escape. I remember being a younger person, and time seemed to drag. How that changes as we age! Now it seems to take off without us. My dad measured time with a Thursday ritual. After supper, he'd roll the garbage cans to the front curb for waste pickup. Without fail, he'd ask no one in particular, "Where did the week go?" Back then I had no idea what he was talking about, but now I do. The mystery of time was not his—or mine—to solve. He'd ask the rhetorical question and then let it go. He valued the present too much to dwell on the past or worry about the future. He chose to embrace each passing moment as a gift from God. As I get older now, I see him as he encourages me to do the same. Lord, open my heart to the wonders of this day.



One might expect that everything would have gone smoothly in the congregations founded by St. Paul. But as we read Paul's letters to these

churches, we witness the same fussing and infighting that many of us experience in our own lives. However, when God's redeemed and sanctified people humble themselves under the mighty hand of God, swallow their pride and put Christ's plans and purpose first and foremost on their agendas, amazing things can be accomplished for the good and growth of God's kingdom. This does not mean that everyone will suddenly agree on every issue. But when we all have the same first love—our Lord Jesus—and have the same priority—carrying out his mission to seek and to save the lost—then his Spirit can remold us into a faithful and fruitful family of believers.


CWL Father's Day BAKE SALE

And this one thing above all else above, GOD, give me a heart that I might love.
