

**Communion Reflection...** My favourite prayers are lamentations. More than a third of the Psalms include lamentations, and I make good use of them. Even as "older" children of God, we are allowed, even encouraged, to cry out like Jesus on the cross, "Why have you forsaken me?" Or weep with Jesus in Gethsemane. Prayers of lamentation are not a sign of doubt, but rather a sure sign of faith. Sometimes we lament in grief, asking for God's grace to enter our sorrowful hearts. Often, our lamentations erupt out of anger because we have been hurt. Yet grace helps us to forgive. Prayers of lamentation sharpen our awareness of being in God's presence every moment. Let the grace of this realization, standing with Jesus in lamentation, flow in us. My heart is filled with gratitude, O Lord, because you hear and answer me when I call.



Our society tends to spotlight and Easter Message honour those who bask in the glory and glitter of success. Every year we

roll out the red carpet for the stars of stage and screen and song. Likewise, we admire and acclaim those who have made it to the top of the ladder in business and industry and politics. However, when we look around with the eyes of faith, we see multitudes of anguished and forsaken people who have fallen between the cracks in our society. Our mission as Christ's redeemed people is to bring the light of Jesus to the forgotten people of the world by entering into solidarity with them. By God's grace, we are able to walk with them into the presence of a Saviour who endured the anguish of rejection and abandonment, so that he might share with us a new life with him, where we will never be rejected or forsaken.


Please pray for our young people who received their First Holy Communion during April and May.
