



Communion Reflection... The soldiers meant to cause Jesus pain, but also to mock him. Amid all the terrible sufferings Jesus bore-abandonment, betrayal, condemnation, torture—why the extra anguish of thorns piercing into his head? A retired friend showed up at church one morning with a gash in his forehead. He'd stood up, felt dizzy and had fallen forward. A head wound causes much bleeding, and it can be scary and alarming. Even days later, after being stitched up at a hospital, it looked painful and unpleasant. For a long time to come, it would be the first thing anybody noticed about him. It's tough to feel love and holiness when you are in pain. Yet we don't get out of our bodies to get to God. The God who accepted the crown of thorns can find in us our present pain and our frail, wounded bodies. He can come closer to us than we know and shine out from within. My hope is in you, Lord, now and always.

How do we know when it's the right time to make a significant change in our life or to take on a new challenge in our Lord's service? God knows. He knew the right time to choose Abraham to be the patriarch of his chosen people. Two thousand years later, at just the

right time in human history, God chose Mary, a descendant of Abraham, to be the mother of the promised Messiah. Two thousand years later, God adopted us into his family through our baptism and faith. He has chosen us at this time in human history to be the channels through which the living Christ is bringing new life and hope and purpose and peace to people around us and around the world. Now is the right time for each of us to be busy serving the living Christ.




Confirmations
