

Communion Reflection... How many times have you been surprised at the growth of God's kingdom? When a pandemic shut down our nation and restrictions seemed to limit our church, God's seed continued to sprout and grow, and we don't know how. Closed doors led to open windows of opportunity, all God's doing—a support group in our neighbourhood, a new ministry online, helping Christian groups in the city. In Acts 8, persecution of the apostles caused believers to flee Jerusalem and start spreading the Good News of Jesus in unexpected places like Samaria. When we are open to God's seed sprouting, God brings rejoicing as we find fresh opportunities for service and witness his kingdom growth, all because of our Saviour changing lives.



Image bearers have two hearts. The first sits in the center of us, pumping away. For many of us, the working of the human heart is a profound mystery. The other

heart isn't a physical one; it's the center of us. It's who we really are. This heart can ache, be fearful, hold secrets, be hopeful or angry and is capable of becoming hard as a diamond. A hard heart is scary. Why? Because it resists the very thing it aches for: the love of God fully expressed by Jesus' birth, the sinless life, his atoning work on the cross and his resurrection on the third day-all for you and me. It's called the Gospel. No known acid can dissolve a diamond. No solvent can break it down. But there is a solvent for a hard human heart, something that has the power to break it down and dissolve it into a soft, thankful heart. It's Jesus.

Our slate is now wiped clean, which means that God accepts us into his family with no strings attached. Empowered and guided by Christ's transforming love, we see everyone with new eyes. We see the difficult people in our family and church family, our workplace and neighbourhood, through the lens of Christ's redeeming love. And that makes all the difference.
