

Communion Reflection... Grace is not

ordinarily something that we can see. Grace is God's favour toward sinners, favour that we could never earn and that we do not deserve. But that invisible grace was made visible at the cross of Jesus. There we see God's love displayed for all the world to see: "While we still were sinners Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8) Now, through faith in Jesus, God's grace is at work in us, "training us to renounce impiety and worldly passions, and in the present age to live lives that are selfcontrolled, upright, and godly." (Titus 2:12) We are called to renounce the world's sinful ways and live as God's holy people. Through our words of witness and our acts of love and service, God's love is displayed for the world to see.



Not infrequently, an aged person dies within weeks or months of their beloved spouse. It is often said that they died of a broken heart. We

can rightly say that Jesus died of a broken heart. On the cross, his heart was broken by all of our loveless words and acts, as well as by our missed opportunities to offer kindness and help and hope to the broken people we encounter. But the comforting message of the Gospel is that on Calvary's cross, Jesus absorbed into his heart not only all of our sins and guilt, but also the anguish and agony and hurt and hate of all humanity. He suffered and died for our sins and the sins of all people, once for all, in order to restore us unrighteous people to a right relationship with our heavenly Father. As God's redeemed and restored children, we are given new opportunities to offer help and hope and healing to the broken people who intersect our lives. By God's grace and guidance, we become his wounded healers.

our own sin life, it seems we can't forget our many trespasses. But Paul said, "Forget what's behind and press on toward...Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:13-14) He seemes to believe in Christ it was possible to forget about the stuff of sin. He'd know; he had lots of bad baggage to forget. This forgetting isn't an act of the will; it's an intentional act of faith in a particular promise God had made centuries before. God had bound himself to it. He said that there'd come a day when the sin he couldn't forget would be forgotten forever. That promise was realized when Jesus died on the cross. This promise realized allowed Paul to say something like "If God has forgotten my sinful stuff, can I do less? For in view of God's mercy in Christ, there's nothing to remember!"
