

It was only accessible once per year, by the high priest who made a special sacrifice for all of Israel's sins. When God supernaturally tore this thick curtain, He made sure it tore from top to bottom—from heaven to earth. He wanted us to know that through the gift of grace, everyone who believes has full access to his inner circle. Since Jesus himself was the sacrifice for all time, we can now boldly approach God's throne in prayer. God is no longer accessible to you. Through top-to-bottom grace, he is Immanuel, God with us.



What would most people say was their life's greatest moment-perhaps the birth of a child, winning an award or fulfilling a dream? What From the Poston has been life's greatest moment for you? Was it when you achieved a lofty goal or perhaps a

time when you triumphed over adversity? Jesus' greatest moment was his moment of ultimate vulnerability, as he was about to breathe his last breath. He had conquered the control of sin and would soon defeat the power of death. When the day draws near for us to breath our final breath, may our most vulnerable moment be our greatest moment, as we complete our earthly mission. May we pray confidently the words of the Psalm which Jesus echoed on the cross, "Into your hand I commit my spirit; you have redeemed me, O Lord, faithful God." But why wait until then? That's a great prayer for the close of every day.
