

Communion Reflection... Now is a perfect time to take a step back and look at what we have around us and within us. God has set us apart as special to him. We thank him by taking good care of ourselves. Our thankful life should also be marked with tenderness toward others. We should be grateful to God for the presence of friends and loved ones in our lives. When things go wrong in relationships, we have the blessing of forgiveness. We thank God for removing divisions. Love keeps us together as a family of God. We thank the Lord for his bond that connects us forever. The peace of Christ calms our hearts and helps us to weather any storm. We enjoy the comfort of knowing that Christ is always with us to soothe our weary souls.



We say, "But wait, Jesus. If I the Pastor's Desk we say, But wait, Jesus. I do that, they won't see my strong faith, they won't understand how tight we are,

how pleased you are with me!" We do things, say things designed to get the attention of other Christians. It's a phase we go through, but it never leaves us completely. Is there a cure for this Christian version of "virtue signaling" – a life that seeks to draw others to myself? Ponder this: "But [Jesus] emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant." A servant doesn't draw attention to himself, but stands by the table, silently making certain that everyone has enough to eat, then clears the dishes. That's the antidote-simple and profound: "I don't need to impress Jesus or his people. I can live a quiet and peaceful life, humbly serving others and getting out of the way." Jesus you made yourself a servant so that I might have everything that matters. Help me to matter less in my own eyes, that others might matter more. Amen.

A special Thank You to Joe Lassaline for allowing us the use of his tractor to gravel and level the back parking lot.



If Jesus could write you a letter what would it say? Perhaps it would be something like this... "Dear (insert your name here - this is personal), From The Pastors Best. Do you know what love is? I have loved you forever-really, forever-and wanted you for my

own. But you and all human beings were more interested in doing things your own way. I left my Father's home in heaven, came to earth to live among you, suffered and died to pay for all your sins. On Easter I rose from the dead, then ascended victoriously to heaven. By grace the salvation I accomplished is yours by faith. By grace you live in my love now and forever. By grace you share my love with everyone you know. Love, Jesus." Lord Jesus, I thank you for your boundless love. Help me to share that love with other.

Advent... is a time to celebrate light in the midst of darkness, as symbolized by the Advent Wreath. The Advent Wreath represents God's love. The evergreen and the circle (wreath) symbolize that God is Eternal and always with us. The candles represent Jesus, the Light of the World....the ONE Light that dispels darkness. The four Advent candles are lit for each of the four Advent Sundays. Advent is traditionally considered a season of penitence and fasting, to prepare for Christmas, and its liturgical colour is purple - the three purple candles reflect this and also the sorrow we feel for not loving Jesus enough. The rose candle is lit on the 3rd Sunday (Gaudete Sunday) in joyful anticipation of Christmas. Some Advent Wreaths have a white candle in the center - this candle represents Christ and is lit on Christmas Day. During the Sundays of Advent all ministers take their positions five minutes early to symbolize our waiting for the Lord. Also, the church moves from darkness to light during the readings. There is no procession of ministers.
