

Communion Reflection... My favourite adverb of Advent comes right from the story of Jesus' birth. "Suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God," the story goes. They shocked the whole world with their surprise song. "Glory to God," they sang, "and peace to God's people on earth." Everything changed in an instant that night. Surprise! God's promise came true. The Third Sunday of Advent is specially marked as an occasion for joy. Amid our Advent preparations, we might be feeling stressed at the work that still never seems to






