Communion Reflection... If you've every seen a campfire, you know how flames burn away the wood until it is nothing but smoke and ash. Imagine Moses' surprise, when he saw a bush on fire but not burning up. It didn't make sense, Moses felt so overwhelmed that he had to look away. God is like that too. God is so great that our minds can't completely make sense of him. We'll never fully understand God's thoughts or even his love for us. He's like the sun blazing on the horizon, so bright that we can't look directly at it, so far away that we could keep walking towards it forever and it would stay out of reach. Yet even though God is greater than us in every way-all knowing, all powerful, all good-he loves us. He's interested in us. He's always reaching out to us, trying to get our attention in the beauty of nature and in the way that people love or need us. It's like he's lighting holy signal fires everywhere, all the time revealing to us: "Here I am!"



Jesus became a human being, like us in all ways except sin. But what does it mean to be "like us" if not for our sins? What is it that belongs to me except for the ways in

which I have failed to live up to the image of God? It is much more appropriate to say that God became man so that we could better understand and receive the grace needed to become who we were originally made to be. Jesus becomes the light by which we see ourselves truthfully.


