Communion Reflection... For me, Holy Communion has come to mean "connectedness." Can we take the grace of Jesus, the love of God, and the Communion of the Holy Spirit and turn all three into a benediction, a wondrous blessing of the fellowship we have with one another in Christ Jesus? When we the people of God come together around the Altar of the Lord to eat of the same bread, we are drawn together in saying, "Any friend of Jesus is a friend of mine." It's no longer you over there, me over here and Jesus way out there somewhere, it's you and I together with Jesus right there in the heart of our relationship. This has been Jesus' dream all along.



A friend told me of his less-than-perfect efforts at running marathons. He was in good physical condition in university, so he figured he could do the run without much trouble. Somewhere along the 7 km mark, his legs and knees started to buckle. He would have fallen to the ground had it not been for two fellow runners who supported him long enough for him to regain some strength and continue the race. When he shared that story, I was reminded of St. Paul's comparing life to a race in which all the runners press forward to claim the prize at the finish line. Though the race is long and hard, the key to winning is keeping our eyes on Christ, knowing we have the support of others to cheer us on.
