**Communion Reflection...** There is a fable about an eagle that could outfly another, and the other eagle didn't like it. The envious eagle saw a sportsman one day and said to him, "I wish you would bring down that eagle." The sportsman replied that he would if he only had some feathers to put on his arrow. So, the eagle pulled one out of his wing. The arrow was shot but didn't quite reach the rival eagle; it was flying too high. The envious eagle pulled our more feathers and kept pulling them out until he lost so many that he couldn't fly. He became the capital sins. Unlike the other capital sins, we derive no pleasure from envy, even though there may be momentary satisfaction in our release of anger. Envy offers no such compensation. Be careful of envy. Do not let it take root in your life. Dismiss it immediately.



God delivered all the commandments. He did not deliver some, or most, but all of the commandments. We are not to pick and choose the ones we wish to follow. We are not the arbiter. We surrender in obedience to

all his commandments. It does not mean that we won't fall short in keeping them. But it does mean that we will do our best to keep them. We are called to accept the commandments–all the commandments–as coming from God. If you have put yourself in the place of God and decided which commandments are valid and which are not, now is your opportunity to seek a change of heart. Please pray for peace and especially the people of Ukraine; join us in saying a Hail Mary every day.
