

From the Pastor Long-lost friends met at a convention and sat in the lobby talking all night long. They knew they would be in trouble with their spouses, who were waiting back in their rooms. When they

saw each other the next day, one of the friends said, "I walked in the door last night, and my spouse got historical." "Don't you mean hysterical?" the other asked. "No, historical," the friend replied. "I was told everything I ever did wrong." In Jewish law, you had to forgive a person three times, and after you'd forgiven them three times, that was it. 
