Communion Reflection... Sometimes we are selfish. We think that what we want matters more than what other people want. We fight to go first or to have the most. We demand that people pay attention to us. John the Baptist wanted people to pay attention to him too, but he didn't want it for himself. He wanted it for Jesus. He wanted to make sure everyone knew that Jesus was coming. John was humble. God wants us to be humble too. After all, everything good in us comes from God. Our job is to let the light of Christ shine through us—not to show everyone how great we are but to let them know how great Jesus is.



Have you every had a “lightbulb moment”? That’s when something suddenly seems clear to you. Maybe it was the perfect idea that came to you all at once or you finally understood how to solve a problem you had. Other times, things become clear to us more slowly. Our conscience can work in both ways. Sometimes we know right away that we’ve done something wrong. Other times, we get a sinking, uneasy feeling later. We might try to ignore it, but it’s like turning away from the sun. You can still feel the heat on your back and see the long shadows it casts in front of you. The start of a new year is a perfect time to turn the light back on. Listen to your conscience and ask Jesus to open the eyes of your heart.


