Communion Reflection... God's promise was not just for the people of Bethlehem. Jesus is God's gift to the whole world. And God announced his birth with the appearance of a bright shining star. The star brilliantly declared that a new king was born for all the world to see. The bible tells us that, through Jesus, we are light. God created you, as God created all light, to shine. We can brightly point out the way to Jesus by what we say and what we do. We can announce to all that Jesus is our King. We can shine God's message of salvation for all the world to see.



Are you afraid of the dark? Many people are. When we can't see what's around us, it's easy to imagine a room full of all kinds of scary things. Even if we tell ourselves that those things aren't real, our minds might still start racing with worry and fear. Night is a time when we let our guard down, so it's normal to feel a little vulnerable. Darkness isn't bad thought. God made darkness, after all, just as he made light, and everything God made is good. The dark might be full of unknowns, but it's really the perfect time to pray. The next time you're feeling worried or afraid, take some deep breaths in and out. As you settle, try picturing God as a light, shining down on you and filling you up. Ask God to be with you through the night and talk to him about anything that is on your mind.

Grief is a journey that we will all encounter at some time in our life, it is very personal but universal and has no time limit. A support group is a proven way to bring comfort, consolation and healing to ourselves and each other. **Grieving with Great Hope** is a 6 week program which provides us with a sacred space to do just that. THE PASTOR'S CORNER A pediatric surgeon, always had a special compassion for the helpless. One day, his son, a second year student in university, was rock climbing. He drove a piton under a large block on a cliff, but the rock loosened sending his crashing one hundred feet. Several hours later the phone rang at the family home. The doctor was told that his son had died. Afterwards, whenever the doctor spoke to the parents of dying children, his throat tightened so he couldn't get the words out. His son's death was keeping him from doing his job, he told his wife. A doctor must never cry. She disagreed, saying, "Now you can empathize." Does the Lord ever really wipe our tears away? He certainly does; but he uses our hands. We all suffer, but what we do with the pain is our choice. We can choose to become cold and bitter, or compassionate and caring. Let us turn those heartaches to heartfelt concern for those struggling and in pain.


