

Communion Reflection... It's not always easy to follow Jesus. Every day, we are tempted to do what is fun or easy instead of what is right. We are tempted to take more than we need, to say things that aren't true or to ignore someone who needs help. It's all these time when it feels like there's a little devil on our shoulder, whispering into our ear. If we open our hearts, though, God will speak to us. That's what our conscience is, after all. It is the voice of God, speaking in our hearts, helping us to know what is right and wrong. We might even picture it as an angel on our shoulder, whispering into our ear things that will please God. How do you know which voice to listen to? God doesn't tell us what we want to hear. He tells us what is loving and good. He reminds us to think about what Jesus would do. God asks us to serve him and to do good for others, not for ourselves but in response to God's love for us in Jesus.

Now we are in the darkness of winter. The sun stays below the horizon for longer. The deep darkness makes other lights shine even more brightly. In the same way, becoming still and quiet again helps us focus on what really matters. It may not be easy. So let's use our prayer time this week to remember. Let's open our hearts and let Jesus be the light that leads us. Dear Jesus, help us stay focused on you.




