**Communion Reflection...** It was reported in a magazine that athletes who intended to participate in the national track and field championship were required to fill out a questionnaire. Among the questions were, "What is your hobby?" and "What is your ambition?" One runner answered, "My hobby is taking apart my truck. My ambition is to be able to put it back together." Now there is a worthwhile ambition. In fact, it is essential that this athlete achieve his goal or there will be quite a mess to clean up! What is your ambition in life? Too easily we offer an answer like: achieve success, a happy marriage, a comfortable retirement. The ambition of the Christian life can be found in the words of Zechariah, "To serve God devoutly, and through all our days be holy in his sight." Take a moment to examine your ambitions. Are they God-inspired and God-centered? Are they founded on serving and loving God? If they are not, perhaps they need some fine-tuning.




