Communion Reflection... There are so many temptations that can easily mislead us, for it is certainly easier to give in and avoid struggle. Wednesday Women The Healing Health Ministry invites all women to a new support group, starting **Wed April 17th, 2024**.

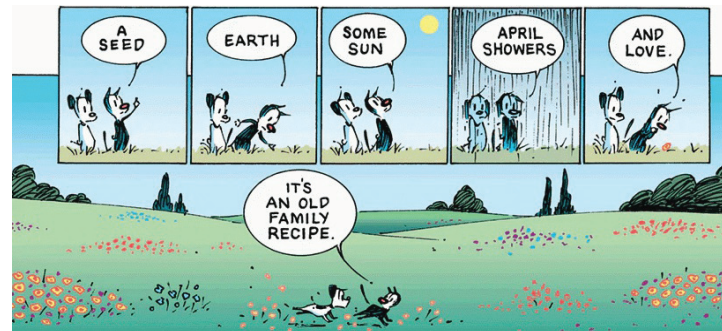
