

Rather, let yourself be guided by the Spirit of God. Look at the legacy the Spirit brings: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These are beautiful things, and make life joyful. They are a foretaste of the joy of heaven. Spirit of the living God, fall afresh on us.



Some people measure love by the gifts they give or the lifestyle they provide. If asked how much he loves his wife, a husband might respond with a long list that includes
