Communion Reflection... In ordinary life, reward follows performance. You must do the work before you get the paycheck. You receive the diploma after you pass all the courses. God's grace is different, the opposite of what we might think. "While we still were sinners Christ died for us." We earn nothing. God makes the first move. His love and grace give us new life and salvation; we do not, cannot, earn or deserve this free gift. Our saviour earned the gift for us at the cross long before we could do anything to deserve this incredible grace. If you fear you may not be good enough to deserve heaven, stop worrying! None of us is "good enough" – that is why Jesus died for us. Trust his word and promise, trust his cross: He is good enough, and more. God's grace trumps our sinfulness. Because of Jesus our guilt is gone. Live today in the glow of God's grace. Fix my faith, Lord, on the cross of Jesus and flood my soul with your loving grace.



PASTOR'S We all face tough times in life. There are financial problems, deaths, and broken relationships. It's up to us to choose how we respond to them. Consume or connect? We can shut down emotionally and drown out the tough

times by consuming too much alcohol, food, or unsafe drugs, or we can be consumed with anger, causing us to lash out at others. The right choice is to connect. Call a friend. Don't isolate and suffer alone-reach out and share your struggles. Talk about your feelings. Attend a support group. Others have been there and can offer helpful insights and encouragement. Take it to God. And if you still find yourself struggling, seek out a professional. Use this week to reach out to someone who is going through a rough patch. Ask, "How can I help?" Then listen.
