Communion Reflection... Each of us is capable of doing some healing, because we have eyes that can see, ears that can hear, tongues that can speak, hands that can touch and, above all, a heart that can love. 1. **Canada Day** is the national day of Canada. A federal statutory holiday, the occasion celebrates the anniversary of July 1, 1867, the effective date of the Constitution Act.

- 2. On July 1, 1867 The British North America Act created the Canadian federal government. This act stated that Canada would become an “independent dominion” (territory) of England, which is why Canada Day was originally called Dominion Day. In 1982 **Dominion Day** was changed to Canada Day after a vote in Parliament.
- 3. To help them design the country's official flag. Parliament asked Canadian in 1963 to draft suggestions. Of the 3,541 patriots who responded, nearly 400 thought a **beaver** should be front and centre before finally deciding to use the iconic maple leaf.
- 4. Canada was derived from the Huron and Iroquois Native American language. The word “**kanata**” translates to village.
- 5. On the weekend of July 1, across the entire country, Canadians drink **1.2 million litres** of alcohol/beer.
