Communion Reflection... Each of us is afraid of something. Some are afraid of heights; others have a fear of flying while still others are afraid of bridges or standing up before a crowd to make a speech. Usually the fear is based on potential physical harm or social embarrassment. Most fears are completely unfounded while a small fraction are based on unfortunate past experiences. The majority of our lives have been filled with events of a more positive nature. God has been good to us and has safely guided us through many genuine dangers in our life. There is little indication that He will stop watching over us. A frightened child will be told by caring parents that he has little to fear because they are at the child's side. Our Heavenly Father tells us the same thing every day. Why don't we believe Him?

be from a priest and often request the purchase of gift cards or electronic payments. Please exercise caution should you receive an email like this and contact the parish via telephone to validate its authenticity.




