Some people are naturally decisive. From the menu they'll choose the fish, not the burger. From dozens of options on swatches, they elect to paint the wall a particular shade of green. This moment of clarity arrives when we finally understand our true nature. Like the blind in so many gospel stories, the scales fall from our eyes as we recognize the limits of our mortality. In that moment, we join the community of the church. That is, we live for the eternal side of the tracks, not the mortal side. We trade up for a measuring cup of what matters. If a value doesn't make it through the doorway of death, we abandon it wholesale. Loving. Forgiving. Welcoming. Sharing. What else passes through the final doorway?

### The Archdiocese of Toronto celebrates the feast day of our archdiocesan patron, St. Michael, on Sun Sept 29.

The name "Michael" comes from the Hebrew meaning "Who is like God?" We have added reason to celebrate the great defender and celestial helper because he is the patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto. Saint Michael's defeat of Satan, rooted in his humble recognition that nothing is greater than God, offers us an example for our daily lives.
