Communion Reflection... What are your gifts? What are your strengths? So often, when we think about our talents, we focus on things like sports, music, dancing, or the ability to do well in school. But that's just a tiny part of what your gifts are all about. Are you a good listener? Are you patient? Can you cheer someone up with a smile? These are all gifts too! In a way they are much more important gifts than sports, school or the arts. Kindness and compassion are ways that we love--and God is love. Every day, especially when we get discouraged, it's good to thank God for something special about ourselves. Then, knowing how important that is, we turn around and, every day, make a habit of letting someone else now how special they are! Take a minute and remember a happy time. What did that feel like? You probably felt a lot of joy and peace. During happy times with friends and family, we feel close. We feel together. We feel one. What messes that up? Knowing that we've hurt someone? Secrets? Lies? Anger? Jealousy? The happy times give us a hint of what God made us for and what he wants for us. All those sins? They take us in the wrong direction. Away from happiness, away from God. We're made for the happy times, both here on earth and forever in heaven. That's why we want to take some time every day--maybe in the evening before we fall asleep--to be honest about ourselves. In the quiet of our own rooms, we can go over and review our day, admit what we've done wrong to God, and ask for his mercy.
