Communion Reflection... We love each other,



We bring our weakness to the Lord every day, and we try, too, to make a habit of making peace with those we've wronged, be reconciled and, as St. Paul tells us elsewhere, to not even "let the sun go down on our anger."




What a mystery we are! We're funny and serious. We can be brave but still get scared sometimes. We understand some things but are puzzled by others. We can give
