Communion Reflection... Helen Keller, who went blind and deaf at nineteen months, said: 'One day I asked a friend of mine who had just returned from a long walk in the woods what she had seen. She replied, "Nothing in particular." 'How was this possible?' I asked myself, 'when I, who cannot hear or see, find hundreds of things to interest me through mere touch. I feel the delicate shape and design of a leaf. I pass my hands lovingly over the rough bark of a pine tree. Occasionally, I place my hand quietly on a small tree, and if I'm lucky, feel the happy quiver of a bird in full song. The greatest calamity that can befall people, is not that they should be born blind, but that they should have eyes, yet fail to see.'

Some days we feel real close to God and God seems real close to us. The weather is beautiful, we had a good night's sleep and worries have taken a brief leave of absence. God and life are very good to us. There are also days when God and we are very far apart, or at least it appears that way. The weather is dreary, nothing has gone right all day, and we feel grouchy and miserable. Thoughts of a kind, loving God are far from our mind. All we can think about is how unhappy we are. Despite our attitude, God is still with us anyway. We may not feel close to Him but, He feels and is so close that He's a part of us. He doesn't just love us when we are pleasant and happy. He made us and will be with us no matter what. God is not a fair weather friend with us. Are we one with Him?
