Communion Reflection... You give but little when you give of your possessions. It is when you give of yourself that you truly give. There are those who give little of the much which they have, and they give if for recognition, and their hidden desire makes their gifts unwholesome. And there are those who have little and give it all. These are the believers in life and the bounty of life, and their coffer is never empty. Through the hands of such as these God speaks, and from behind their eyes he smiles upon the earth.



Curious children will sometimes ask parents how they met. Usually the story involves a chance meeting, a date, attendance at the same school or co-workers of the same employer. Sometimes a little of each situation is

involved. Occasionally one partner will admit to loving their future mate right away although the other party wasn't at all aware of the attraction. Eventually, the clueless party caught on and "the rest is history." St. John writes in his Epistle, "Love, then, consists in this: not that we have loved God but that He has loved us." Sometimes it takes a while before we realize how much God has loved us from the very beginning. The realization begins when we try to consider where we would be without Him. Once we understand how much we mean to Him, we might want to start returning that Love.



Will we continue to remember our war heroes? I hope so. Some say "let the dead bury their dead," however, and with many veterans passing on, the future of Remembrance Day can seem as bleak as a November sky. The lapel pins we wear on

Remembrance Day actually started as a fund-raiser for Belgian children orphaned by the Great War. Will our own children care in the future? They should. It is important to use this day as an opportunity to encourage people to think about where we've gotten using war as a solution to our problems, to think about the lives lost and to think about new ways we can make the world a better place. There are so few people left alive who know what a global war is like. Soon, there won't be any. We wear the poppy in remembrance. If the poppy, a symbol of death and loss, doesn't also serve as a potent symbol of the need for peace, what could? You can tell people what happened long ago, and that's history – nothing can change it, but it is not something that should be forgotten, nor should the men and women who gave so much for the freedom we now enjoy. On November 11 we remember those who gave their life for others, our war heroes and our first responders.

During the month of November, we take the time to pause and remember those who have died and await the resurrection of the body at the end of time, especially those in our parish cemeteries. "May the Lord grant eternal rest to them and send his comfort and strength to us, the living, as we look forward to our reunion, one day, in the glory of God's eternal kingdom in heaven."

names will be remembered at the Masses during the year, along with candles at the altar. All donations will be used for Masses, Memorial Candles, and Sanctuary improvements.
