

Communion Reflection... Human beings are frail and foolish. We have been told that grace is to be found in the universe. But in our human foolishness and short-sightedness we imagine divine grace to be finite, and for this reason we tremble. But the moment comes when our eyes are opened, and we see that grace is infinite. Grace demands nothing from us but that we await it with confidence and acknowledge it with gratitude. Grace makes no conditions and singles out none of us in particular. Grace takes us all to its bosom and proclaims a general amnesty.



The message of the Gospel, first preached in Galilee, is to be spread today through us. The word of God which first came to birth in our souls at baptism is anxiously waiting to burst forth and take root in the lives of others. Every year is a year of favour from the Lord. There are many ways we

can make these words of Christ, about bringing glad tidings to the poor, liberty to captives and sight to the blind, our very own and have them fulfilled in our hearing. When we help those whose hearts have grown cold and are heavily weighed down, the love of God shines through us and we make them realize that Jesus Christ is not a memory but is living among us today. To be successful channels of his message we have first to put our own house in order, by accepting the good news of Jesus. A question for all of us to ponder is – what is the Good News proclaimed by my life to others today? There is nowhere we can walk in life without leaving the imprint of who we are, good or bad, upon the ground we tread.
