

Communion Reflection... On Feb 2nd the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas day, Christ is the light of the nations, hence the blessing and procession of candles on this day. In obedience to the Old Law, the Lord Jesus, the first-born, was presented in the Temple by his Blessed Mother and his foster father. This is another 'epiphany' celebration insofar as the Christ Child is revealed as the Messiah through the canticle

and words of Simeon and the testimony of Anna the prophetess. The Presentation of the Lord concludes the celebration of the Nativity and with the offerings of the Virgin Mother and the prophecy of Simeon, the events now point toward Easter.

PASTOR'S

Our earth seems so stable that when a storm or earthquake occurs and changes the landscape we are shocked beyond imagination. We marvel how a natural disaster can transform the land so radically. It all reminds us that this world is not
