

They are counting on you to nurture the plants and tend them, so that they will return to enjoy a rich and fruitful harvest. It is this sort of nurturing, caring, and tending of which we speak, in a much more profound way, when we explore the call to be children of God. When we apply this to our lives, we see that understanding ourselves as children of God can be lifechanging. All you are, have, and will be is God's and it is entrusted to you.



So many times, something or someone comes into our path and we think how wonderful it would be to have that thing or that person. We think that we would

be so happy if we could only get what we wanted. And yet, if we paused to really reflect on what was going on, we would soon discover that this promise of pleasure or happiness is only an empty one.
