**Communion Reflection...** To know oneself as a child of God and a follower of Jesus, we must be rooted in a deep, trustful relationship with God through the Holy Spirit. This is only possible within the context of the lifeline of prayer. Prayer, where our hearts meet the heart of God, leads us to know God and to find joy in seeking and doing God's will. Through prayer, we see God and ourselves more clearly. Prayer relies on and creates in us an open heart and mind. We are able to put aside the all-too-common pursuit of control, power, and influence, and instead come to value the qualities of God's children: humility, gentleness, patience, peace, and kindness. In humble honesty in prayer, we recognize how utterly dependent we are upon God's providence. With hearts that have been opened to the love and mercy of God, we find our hands opening as well, to freely share ourselves and our resources with others, and to receive what God wants us to have, trusting that God will provide all we need, as God has and always will.



We may know the special place that the patriarchs and matriarchs, from Abraham to Leah, played in God's plan of salvation for all people. But how could someone like me, as insignificant as I feel, possibly make a difference in carrying out God's plans and purposes? You may have heard the story of the child on the beach, picking up starfish stranded by the tide and throwing them back in the ocean. When a parent suggested it was foolish because there were so many, the child tossed one more into the waves and replied, "I made a difference for that one." We can't share God's light and love and saving grace with everyone. But we can be God's presence and make a life-saving difference for someone who is drowning in their guilt and shame, or is living in the depths of despair. We can point them to Christ, and invite them to live with us in God's marvellous and eternal light.

FIFTH SUNDAY  
In Lent

Every time we offer a gift, we offer a little bit of our love along with it. That's why ingratitude is such a serious offense. It's not just the gift that's been rejected. Ingratitude not only wounds the gift giver, but affects the one who's receiving the

gift, blinding them to the presence of others, which is dangerous territory. If you can't see others, soon enough you'll not see Jesus either. We don't often think of being thankful during Lent. But thanksgiving during Lent makes perfect sense. Why? Because each Lenten day, the cross upon which our Saviour died looms even larger. Each day in Lent brings us closer to the day when Jesus unleashed life upon the world. Jesus sent a whole lot of his love with this gift. We stand in awe of that kind of fierce, determined love and realize the Lord is dissolving our sometimes hard hearts to a thankfulness that looks quite a lot like tears.
