### Communion Reflection... As Holy Week

begins, we join those crowds praising Jesus, accompanying him as he enters Jerusalem. What a scene! But what about the rest of the week—after the church service is over and the palms tucked away? How can I stay with Jesus, faithful to the end? I can read the Gospels. I can pray. But there's another way too. For what has Jesus told me over and over? "Just as you did it to one of the least of these... you did to me." Simply; in accompanying others in their suffering, I'm accompanying Jesus on his way to the cross, this week and always. By listening, being present and reaching out any way I can—even in prayer, I'm there with Jesus in the suffering of others. Together, we'll journey this week, with hope, trust, mercy and grace.



Who are you? Who are you called to be?

What are you called to do? These are

questions at the heart of growing as a

disciple of Jesus Christ. Who are you? A

child of God. Who are you called to be? A

member of Christ's body. What are you

called to do? Grow and live in holiness. To be holy is to desire God above all else, to seek God's ways and do God's will, to live and share Christ's love in the world. We are never finished holiness projects. If we strive to grow as God's children and Christian disciples, we will embrace a life of ongoing conversion, of becoming more like Christ each day. With every time of prayer, participation in the liturgy, and reading of sacred Scripture, you will become closer to God and will more fully perceive God's desire for you and for the world. With each decision or action, time of service, and interaction with family, friends, and coworkers, you may share the truth of Jesus Christ's saving mission of love.

**Holy Thursday** On this day, Jesus offered the very first Mass, fed His followers for the first time with the Holy Eucharist and ordained the first priests. He showed the depth of His love by washing the feet (the act of a servant) of His apostles, and urged us to do the same. After Mass on this night, we take time to adore Jesus in the Eucharist and thank Him for His great love.



**Good Friday** Because of the wonderful act of love that Jesus performed, giving His life that we might all be able to live forever in His kingdom of love, peace and grace. We kiss the cross and try to understand why anyone would care so much about us.

**Holy Saturday** Also known as "Holy." Tonight, those who have been preparing to become Christian accept Baptism and Confirmation. On this night we keep watch for the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead and sing the first "Gloria" and "Alleluias" of the Easter Season. We ring the bells to announce the Resurrection and the promise of new life. We all renew the vows of our Baptisms. May each of these days be special to us. May we each be prepared through Penance to receive the new life promised us by Christ. And may the Good Shepherd bless our parish family with special love and peace.

How would we know glory if we saw it? Those who'd witnessed Jesus' ride into Jerusalem thought they'd gotten a glimpse of it. But once the hosannas ended, things came apart. That's what happens to our idea of glory. Just when we think we have it, it's gone. A man lies dying. His daughter enters, "Don't worry, Dad; you'll be fine." The father turns towards the chaplain, who makes the sign of the cross on his forehead, "You're a baptized child of God, and no one and nothing can change that Gospel fact." The man relaxes. God's glory was hidden in the man's suffering. The father understood; the daughter didn't. Soon the father would feel the weight of God's glory, but not there. Did any of the witnesses of the crucifixion understand that they were witnessing God's glory up there? Not many, but they were. God's glory from the cross continues to reveal itself in our world today. But do we see it? Let us look closely to find it, especially in hard times. Father, remind me that you're preparing the weight of your glory even through my suffering.

**Garden of Lilies...** Easter is a time when we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus and remember our loved ones. If you would like to bring an Easter Lily to Church in memory of a loved one, we will place it in the sanctuary and offer prayer intentions at every mass for the 6 weeks of Easter. 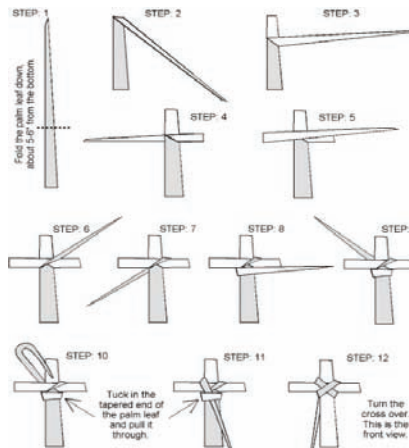

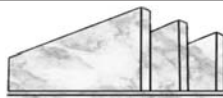
