Communion Reflection...

On Easter, our thoughts often turn to heaven. However, we often think of heaven as this less-than-real place. Call it "heaven-lite." Why? Maybe because we cannot imagine anything weightier or more real than sickness, doubt, pain, betrayal, discord. The effects of sin are weighty, crushing even! But why should our "less-than-real" ideas about heaven dominate us, when the biblical description is very real? After he was raised on the first Easter, Jesus passed through the locked door of the room where the disciples were—not because he wasn't as real as the door, but because he was actually even more real than the door. He walked through that door as we walk through fog. The disciples thought he was a ghost until he ate with them. He showed them that he was real and risen. Jesus is real for us today on this Easter too, and he is alive for each of us. Jesus the Real One, has prepared a real place for us in his Father's house. If it were not so, he would have told us. Christ has risen from the tomb to walk with us there, one solid footstep at a time.



Very early on the miraculous morning, the sorrowful women returned to the tomb to pay their last respects to their crucified king. They had prepared their spices for burial. But they were not prepared for what they found. There was no dead Jesus where they laid him, only an empty tomb. They were stunned! But soon the words of the angels transformed their agony into ecstasy and their bitter sorrow into unspeakable joy. We are never in ecstasy when we prepare to lay a precious loved one to rest. But our sorrow is muted by the joy and assurance of our Easter faith. Christ is risen! He is the resurrection and the life. That makes all the difference in the world in the midst of our pain, tears and fears. Because he lives, we can face every tomorrow, knowing where we and all who have died in the faith will spend eternity. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!




