**Communion Reflection...** Imagine your most favourite day. It could include a long, lingering visit with a loved one, a walk in the park or a hike in the woods, an afternoon of service, or a cozy spot with a good book. Now dig deeper. What makes the day so special? Beyond the specific activities that comprise such moments, what really makes the day special is time—time to be present with the ones we love and those who need our care; time to walk, hike, or play our favourite sport; time to curl up with a good book. Time. None of us knows how much time we have on this earth. We do know that at some point, our lives on earth will end. Time is a gift. When we spend time well, we use it responsibly, we use it to share God's love and contribute to our family, parish, and the world, through our presence, service, and work.



Social media platforms help connect us with friends and family. That's a good thing. We post pictures and make comments and wait for the response icons.

But the "person" we portray on those platforms doesn't even exist. How is that so? It is because in our posts we edit out the pain, failures, fears—the stuff we hide from ourselves and others. It's a fantasy life we project to others. Turn to the Psalms and we see a very different way of presenting the self. The Psalmist never "spins" life. When he's downcast, he says it in language that's often raw to the core, but he always anticipated that the Lord's there to help, rescue and lift him up again. The woman at the well attempted to "spin" her life to Jesus. And so, gently but firmly he led her to confess the real woman. It was painful. But then he rid her of her disgrace and gave her a new life. Jesus leads us to revealing our true selves and receiving real renewing responses from him. Lord, help me to be honest about myself. I want to be healed again and again.

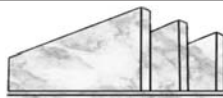
