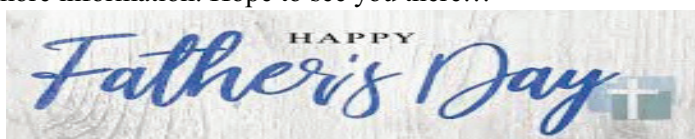

Communion Reflection... What do you treasure? So often, when people think of the word "treasure" the first thing that comes to their mind is "money." It is unfortunate. The reaction comes in part from the word rarely being used outside of the request for financial giving. It is unfortunate because it limits the power treasure has to make a difference in the ways in which faith directs our lives. When we speak of treasure, we are usually referring to money. Yet there is something deeper at work. What do we treasure? Do we treasure money for the good it can do, or does money signify security or status? How much do we really need? Even while many of us spend much of our lives acquiring financial resources, deep in our hearts we know that money only goes so far. What we really treasure cannot be bought. The things in life that are most important are not things. Our only true security is in God's providence. Our true status is as children of God and disciples of Jesus Christ.



In ordinary life, reward follows performance.

You must do the work before you get the paycheck. You receive the diploma after you pass all the courses. God's grace is different, the opposite of what we might think. "While we still were sinners Christ died for us." We earn nothing. God makes the first move. His love and grace give us new life and salvation; we do not, cannot earn or deserve this free gift. Our saviour earned the gift for us at the cross long before we could do anything to deserve this incredible grace. If you fear you may not be good enough to deserve heaven, stop worrying! None of us is "good enough" – that is why Jesus died for us. Trust his word and promise, trust his cross: He is good enough, and more. God's grace trumps our sinfulness. Because of Jesus our guilt is gone. Live today in the glow of God's grace. Fix my faith, Lord, on the cross of Jesus and flood my soul with your loving grace.

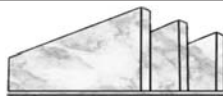
