Communion Reflection... Being created in God's image and likeness means that you are called to collaborate with God in the ongoing process of creation. God places all of creation in our care, and this is a sacred responsibility. To make something sacred means to make it holy; God entrusted the earth and all who dwell in it into our hands in a partnership of holiness. At the moment of creation, God said, "It is good." All that God created must be reverenced as "good." The pinnacle of creation, of course, is humankind, and so the care of creation begins with a deep reverence for human life. The earth water, and creatures are to be reverenced too, as we recognize the sacred trust with which God gives all this to us. Disregard for people and natural resources is at its depth a breaking of the sacred responsibility each of us has to care for creation.



Every morning when I first wake up, there is a moment – an instant, really – when my whole is still calm, peaceful. I don't yet remember yesterday's worries or today's plans. I haven't yet evaluated the day and its challenges, or

even assessed how my body feels. When you live with a chronic condition, especially one that involves pain, it's far too easy to live anticipating suffering and preparing for difficulty. But that first breath or two is a moment full of grace, it reminds me what it's like to bring no baggage into my day. It's what I hear Jesus saying to the Twelve when he directed them to "take nothing for the journey." Each morning, Jesus urges me to let go, take nothing with me... to walk into my day counting solely on him who is my Lord. No, it's not easy. But it is do-able.

The Body of Christ. The gift of His real presence teaches a paradox about the two realms of being. In the physical world the lower form of life becomes the higher when it is consumed. Elements are consumed by plants; plants are consumed by animals, animals are consumed by humans. Therefore, the lesser becomes the greater. In the spiritual

realm the greater being, Jesus, lowers Himself to be consumed by the lesser being, we disciples, in order that we can be raised up. We celebrate a "tripod" of Jesus' comprehensive presence. First, we have the gift of His real presence in the **Eucharist**. Second, He is present to us via **people** in the church and in the Holy Orders of deacon, priest, and bishop. Third, He is present to us in His **Word**. For this reason we stand at the Gospel just as we would if an honored guest entered our home. All three "legs of this tripod" are important if His presence is to truly work in the world. Take one away – each "leg" will continue to be real, but the "tripod" may fall over and be unable to carry the weight it was meant to hold.


