It can be difficult to live within our families—there can be lots of competing interests. One commentator said, "If you can't live within a family, you won't be able to live in society either." Is it hard to live within a family? Sure—harder still to live without them. We were made for community. Image bearers do not do well alone. We need each other. God told us it would be this way: "It is not good that a man should be alone" (Genesis 2:18). As Christians, we belong to two different families. The first is determined by our DNA, the second determined by H<sub>2</sub>O and God's promise. Under extreme conditions, we might walk away from our blood families. Or maybe they will walk away from us. We might be tempted to walk away from our water-based family, too, but this is God's family; it can't disown us. Because, at the end of life, water is thicker than blood.
