Communion Reflection... Much has been written and said about how we are not called to "do" church, or "go to church," but rather to "be" church. Being a member of Christ's body is about who we are, which in turn informs and shapes what we do. This is not a singular, solo endeavour. It is not "me and Jesus," but "we and Jesus." Being drawn to Christ in the waters of baptism, we are at the same moment forever linked to one another. Living and growing as stewards leads us to see more readily that all are created in God's image; each is entrusted with abundant gifts; all have a particular contribution to make as a child of God and Christian disciple. We much more readily embrace the life of stewardship when we are firmly rooted in the community of faith. Our faith is strengthened, as is our resolve to discern Christ's call and freely give in response to the gracious gifts that are poured out upon us. Together, we grow as disciples, recognize our blessings and witness the grace of God at work among us and within us.



There comes a time in every child's life when they're able to fit into some of their parent's clothes. This can be an important milestone for parents but it can also be a source of annoyance. Children don't
