

Communion Reflection... One of the most crucial questions we ponder in our lives is that of vocation. Who are you, and what are you called to do? In a fundamental way, we share a common vocation as Christian disciples. To be a disciple is our vocation. But there is a personal vocation that must be considered as well. What shape will this discipleship take in your life? All of these questions of vocation are given clarity when we recall that the root of the word "vocation" is the Latin vocare, which means to call. Christ calls each of us personally. Beyond the call to a particular state of life-priesthood, religious life, married, or committed single life-there are calls that we discern and live out throughout our lives. In this sense, there is no singular, once-and-for-all calling. Rather, your entire life as a Christian is a process of recognizing and responding to God's grace. You do this most profoundly when you acknowledge the gifts you have been given and discern what work or service most needs what you have to give.



How many times have you been surprised at the growth of God's kingdom? When a pandemic shut down our nation and restrictions pandemic shut down our nation and rest continued to sprout and grow, and we don't

know how. Closed doors led to open windows of opportunity, all God's doing—a support group in our neighbourhood, a new ministry online, helping Christian groups in the city. In Acts 8, persecution of the apostles caused believers to flee Jerusalem and start spreading the Good News of Jesus in unexpected places like Samaria. When we are open to God's seed sprouting, God brings rejoicing as we find fresh opportunities for service and witness his kingdom growth, all because of our Saviour changing lives.

Teacher Candidates... The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board requires all teacher applicants to submit a pastoral portfolio/reference when applying for a teaching position. It is the

responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday liturgy, be involved in parish life and contact the parish priest well in advance. Teacher candidates who are attending school out of the local area are also responsible to give the pastor advance notice. The pastor cannot complete the form if he does not know the applicant.
