

Communion Reflection... Of all of the moments recorded in the gospels, one of the most challenging and compelling is that of Jesus washing the feet of his disciples. It was at the Last Supper, his final meal with them before he entered into his passion and crucifixion. Jesus knew that the time had to come for him to give himself for the sake of the world. In that moment, he wanted to express what is most important. He gave his disciples—us—a command: "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." To love so completely, to serve as Jesus calls us to serve, we must be willing to see the needs of the people around us—in our families, at work, in our parishes and schools, in our local communities and the world. Have you ever noticed that the more you serve, the more comfortable you become doing so? The more you witness and experience the service of others, the more inspired you will be to reach out in love and care.



A dear friend, journeying through his share of adversity, came across a less-than-helpful quote by Augustine: "Whenever we suffer some affliction, we should regard it both as a punishment and as a correction." My friend was not exactly encouraged by this sentiment.

We all see the reality of suffering in our own lives and the lives of those we love. To be sure, we often endure the consequences of our mistakes and sins. But if we see our heavenly Father only as one who punishes and corrects, we will never experience the peace, love and mercy of being his adopted children. Jesus did not come to take away every earthly hardship. Instead, he binds up our wounds with his own, transforming and redeeming us as we enter into the mystery of his death and resurrection.


For last weekend's 2nd collection for Mission Co-op and for making Fr. Sojan feel welcome.
