Communion Reflection... No two people are

Christian in the same way. The process of growing as a disciple is very personal. It requires you to reflect on where you are in your life, hear the voice of God calling you, and consider what you must do to live more fully as a follower of Jesus, now, on this day, in this place. Every day holds the possibility to use your God given gifts and resources. Develop the habit of starting each day with a simple prayer in which you ask God to show you who needs your time, attention, prayer, talents, or resources. End the day by reflecting on the ways you did or did not reflect the love and mercy of God in your interactions with others and the decisions you made. Did you fail to spend time with God in prayer? Did you selfishly hold on to a possession? Did you look the other way when you encountered someone who needed you? Tomorrow is a new day. Use it well.



Most of us have imagined what it would be like to see Jesus face to face. If only we could turn back time for just a brief moment and stand in His presence, it would bring us such peace. We often forget that Jesus lived in a world with

just as many uncertainties and threats to peace as our own. His people were subjects of the Roman Empire and had to do whatever they were told whenever the Emperor or local official told them. Our century is filled with reasons to feel helplessly at the mercy of events beyond our control. We have only a little more influence on world events than some of the people of Jesus' time. That's why His message has so much to say to us today. Jesus tried to teach His listeners that all the worldly authorities didn't matter. Jesus told Pilate, "You would have no power over me whatsoever; unless, it were given you from above." May we never forget Who is really in charge here.


