Communion Reflection... Think of a time when you felt a deep sense of satisfaction in a job well done. Chances are, what you were doing was not always easy. The extra effort, care, or time given came from a heightened sense of responsibility, something that you needed to accomplish, that required your talents or time, something only you could do. Now, look back at the whole of your life. How many of those moments of satisfaction stand out? What is the cumulative sum of all of the time you have spent with God or others, the talents you have contributed at your workplace, parish, or world, the resources you have willingly shared for the sake of others? To be a Christian disciple is a rewarding way of life, a way of companionship with Jesus, and the practice of stewardship as part of it is itself a source of deep joy. Those who live this way are happy people who have found the meaning and purpose of living.



Lord Jesus, we pray for all the sheep that are lost, but our hearts go out especially to the lost lambs. Have mercy on the human wolves who steal, exploit, and sometimes kill the lambs of the Father's flock; help them to see the horror of what they are doing. Comfort the grieving parents who in many cases don't even have the consolation of a burial service. In your merciful love grant that those lambs, though lost here, may be found hereafter. Watch over those who are still straying here below. Guide them along the paths that are safe. Send shepherds to look for them. And open the eyes of society so that we may cease to regard property as more important than people.

telling you what you mean to Him.

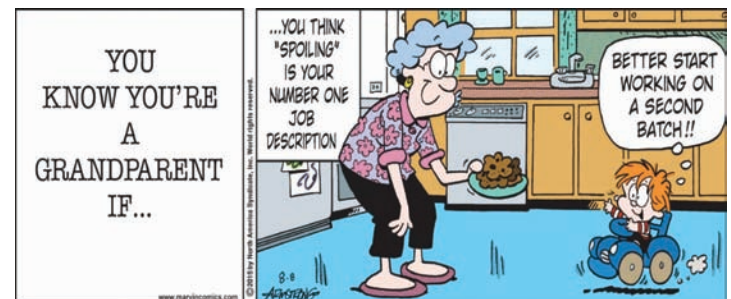
Reconciliation/1st Communion & Confirmation

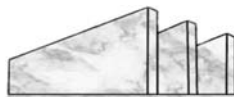

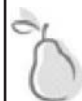
