

Communion Reflection... Violin notes hung over the street, sweet and silken. This was no ordinary street musician! Caught off guard by the unexpected beauty, Steve Lopez, a columnist for the Los Angeles Times, followed his ear to Nathaniel Ayers, a homeless man performing a skid row concert using a heavily worn instrument with only two strings. The story of Lopez and Ayers, a Julliard-trained violinist with schizophrenia, is well documented in Lopez's book The Soloist and in the movie by the same title. The story begs an important question: If we believe all people are created in God's image, why are we amazed when a homeless person has remarkable talent? Advent calls us to expect the unexpected. Our Messiah comes not in kingly robes or priestly privilege, but as the son of a poor peasant girl, born among animals. It is so radical it's ridiculous. Why, then, are we surprised to find rich gifts in the world's gutters? Isn't that where we should begin our search for the sacred?



Jesus might ask each of us the same thing. From the Pastor "What did you go to Mass to see?" Did you go to be strengthened by the Eucharist, to hear the Good News? Or did

you go out of obligation or habit, because it's what you're supposed to do? Or maybe you weren't expecting anything at all. Today, let's ask ourselves, what do we get to see at Mass? What does this sacrifice, memorial, and celebration mean for us? (Incidentally, there's a lot to see at Mass today. Look for the rose colour everywhere.)
