Communion Reflection... Do you remember these words from St. Paul? "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman." God knew exactly what he was doing and when he was going to do it, namely, "to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as children." Think about it. When that official decree went out from Emperor Augustus, God had you and me in mind. When the angel Gabriel came to Mary with the news of her being the mother of Jesus, he had you and me in mind. When the angels appeared to the shepherds with the news of peace to all the world, God had you and me in mind. When the star over Bethlehem led the wise men to the manger, God had you and me in mind. No wonder we're told, "Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart." God had a plan. The plan was perfectly timed to include you and me, so that "in the fullness of time," we too came to be. It's all according to God's plan.



When Ahaz refuses to tempt the Lord, it sort of makes sense, doesn't it? After all, in the Gospel, Jesus says, "You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test." But

Ahaz was a terrible, weak king. He even sacrificed his own son to idols. Now, as powerful enemies threatened Jerusalem, God gave Ahaz a chance to trust him. Ahaz wouldn't do it. Eventually, things ended badly for him. On the other hand, our guy Joseph "was a righteous man." In critical moments, he trusted God. Joseph's good decisions didn't just happen. They grew from a lifetime of good habits; loving and serving God. What ideas have come to you during Advent for how you would like your family to keep living in God's love after Christmas? Pray about it over the next few days.






125th Anniversary of St. John's - Aug 2026 We will be starting a committee to help plan and run the event to celebrate 125 years in the life


