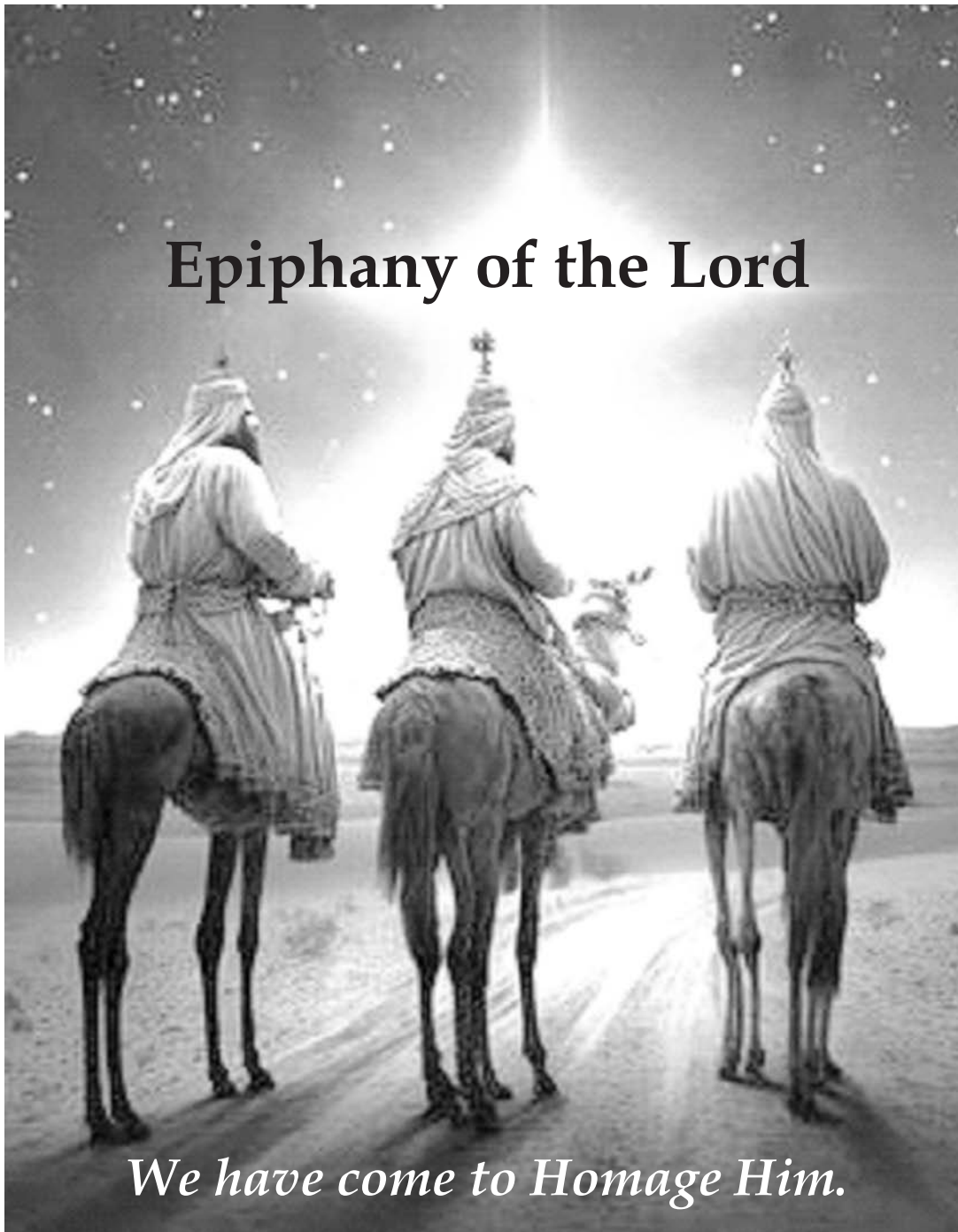

Communion Reflection... The Magi were led to Christ by the light of a star. But they saw the star only because they were not afraid to travel in the dark. The fact is, we cannot see that stars in the bright light of the day, but only in the darkness of night; and the darker the night, the brighter they shine. In a sense, all of us are night-time travelers. However, we need no longer fear the darkness, because with the coming of Christ a light has come into the world, a light that shines in the dark, a light that no darkness can overpower.

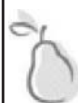
