Presentation of the Lord... On Feb 2nd

the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas day, Christ is the light of the nations, hence the blessing and procession of candles on this day. In obedience to the Old Law, the Lord Jesus, the first-born, was presented in the Temple by his Blessed Mother and his foster father. This is another 'epiphany' celebration insofar as the Christ Child is revealed as the Messiah through the canticle and words of Simeon and the testimony of Anna the prophetess. The Presentation of the Lord concludes the celebration of the Nativity and with the offerings of the Virgin Mother and the prophecy of Simeon, the events now point toward Easter.

Join us **Mon Feb 2 at 7 pm** to celebrate the Feast of Presentation of the Lord with a special **Candlemas Mass**. The Candlemas name comes from the tradition of blessing candles, symbolizing Christ as the light of the world, and marks the end of the Christmas season. Bring your own candles for blessing or buy some from the parish at \$5.




