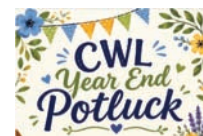

Communion Reflection... Trying to control her dry hair, a woman treated her scalp with olive oil before washing it. Worried that the oil might leave an odour, she diligently washed her hair several times. That night when she went to bed, she leaned over to her husband and asked, "Do I smell like olive oil?" "No," he said, sniffing her. "Do I smell like Popeye?" Sin has a kind of stench. We all have it. Some just don't acknowledge it. We spend more time comparing ourselves to others. We rationalize our goodness at times by putting others down in our minds: "At least I am not like so-and-so." We are to focus on ourselves—recognizing our sinfulness, yet not giving in to discouragement. May we sincerely offer the prayer: "O God, be merciful to me a sinner." That is a prayer that God always hears.



A friend of mine was once asked, "How does God love me?" My friend thought for a minute and said, "I guess through me God loves you." I have never forgotten that. But then, where does that love come from, the love that spills over from one heart to the hearts of others? It starts with Jesus. And having started with Jesus on the cross, it never stops. By the grace of God, it takes over the heart and soul of a person until God's love and forgiveness covers over "a multitude of sins." It is then that a loved and redeemed child of God can say, "I guess through me God loves you." And he does. Love starts with Jesus and takes off like a rocket until we want nothing more than to share it with others.

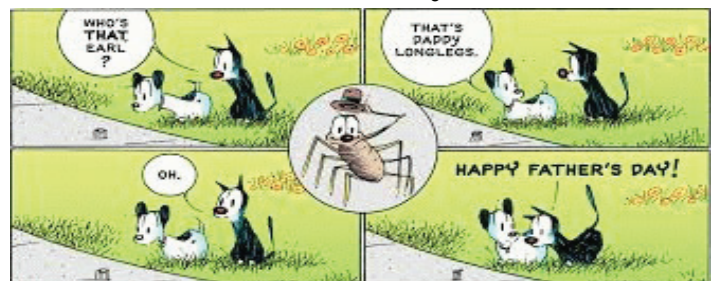
